Go to www.brinkx.org . Scan the home page, known as Base Camp, and answer the following questions:

1. What does the word brink mean? _____

2. Go to Latest news. Find the section that shows where the Brink Boys are now, click on 'HERE' and locate Recife on the map that appears. This is the city where the expedition sailed from in late May 2004. Name the smaller historical city just to the north of Recife.

3. Click on Back and return to Base Camp.
4. Locate the photo of Peter Garrett on the right hand side of the page and click on it. What is the name of the organisation that he is president of?

5. Click on Gallery on the left hand side of the page. View the photos in one of the photo files by clicking on one of the four photos or the name of the country beneath them. Describe one of the photos that you like.
